E	AS IN THE <b>E</b> IN EGG
I	AS IN THE <b>EE</b> IN SEE
O	AS IN THIS <b>OR</b> THAT
U	AS IN THE <b>OO</b> IN BOOT

THERE ARE BASICALLY **2** OF THESE IN THE MAORI LANGUAGE

**NG** PRONOUNCED LIKE THE NG IN **SINGER**

**WH** PRONOUNCED AS IN THE LETTER **F**

CONSONANTS ARE MANLY PRONOUNCED AS THEY ARE IN ENGLISH **EXCEPT**

THE **T** WHEN SUCCEEDED BY AN **A, E or O**

THE **R** IS A ROLLED **r** IF YOU CAN IMITATE THE purr OF A CAT.
